- 33rd APANPIRG Meeting was held in Bali, Indonesia from 22 to 24 November 2022 in the hybrid format
- Attended by 326 participants from 30 Member States, 2 SARs of China, and 7 International Organizations (ACI, CANSO, IATA, ICAO, IFALPA, IFATSEA and PASO)
- Meeting adopted 13 Conclusions and 1 Decision

APANPIRG/33 – Key Outcomes

- Monitor and track implementation of **Beijing Declaration**
- State Action Plan for Establishment and Implementation of Wildlife Hazard Management Programme (WHMP) - Generic Template
- Major Update of Asia/Pacific SAR Plan, primarily to include GADSS elements (ATM/SG)
- Major Update of Asia/Pacific Regional Framework for Collaborative ATFM (ATM/SG)
- Established the timeframe for the implementation of SWIM
- Revised Surveillance Strategy for the APAC Region
- Published ATM Automation System Implementation and Operations Guidance Document
- Advance preparation for planned upgrades to WAFS, SADIS and WIFS, including 0.25-degree WAFS hazard data



APANPIRG/33 – Key Outcomes (Cont'd.)

- ICAO APAC Webinars/Workshops/Seminars conducted:
 - ATM (3 in 2022 and 3 in 2023)
 - AOP (1 in 2022 and 2 in 2023)
 - CNS (4 in 2022 and 7 in 2023)
 - MET & ENV (3 in 2022 and 1 in 2023)

Main Air Navigation Priorities for 2023

- 1) AOP:
 - Master Plan for Aerodromes and Transition from ICAO ACN-PCN to ICAO ACR-PCR Method of Reporting Aerodrome Pavement Strength
- 2) ATM:
 - Update the Asia/Pacific Seamless ANS Plan to Version 4
 - Update the Regional ATM Contingency Plan to further elaborate on lessons learned from major ATS disruptions in the last three to four years, and associated obligations of States
- 3) RASMAG
 - Identify and monitor Large Height Deviation (LHD) Hot Spots
 - Address and attempt to rectify the issue of rogue State aircraft operating in the RVSM band



Main Air Navigation Priorities for 2023 (cont'd)

4) CNS

- All States to join the CRV program before 31 December 2023
22 Member States joined CRV.
- ATM Infrastructure Operations Capability Building in Lao PDR project completion
Completed
- Publish the Asia Pacific Regional Aeronautical Radio Frequency Management Guidance Material
Completed



Main Air Navigation Priorities for 2023 (cont'd)

5) MET

- Volcanic ash exercises (especially in PSIDS)
- Coordination of SIGMET information
- Dissemination of MET information in IWXXM form
- ICAO space weather service
- Amendment 81 of Annex 3, including the new PANS-MET



APAC Key Challenges in Air Navigation

- ❑ Recovery of ANSPs and aerodromes from the impact of COVID-19 pandemic
- ❑ Accelerate progress of Beijing Declaration Commitments in implementing the Priority Elements of APAC Seamless ANS Plan
- ❑ More resources to improve compliance with ICAO provisions
- ❑ Accelerate progress in development of NANP compatible with RANP
- ❑ More Effective Engagement of PSIDS in ICAO Meetings and important activities (Webinars, Workshops, etc)
- ❑ Unavailability of ATS in Kabul FIR – ongoing since 16 August 2021.
- ❑ Close resource shortage gap to support ANS infrastructure planning and implementation



APAC Key Challenges in Air Navigation (Cont'd)

- ❑ Need to accelerate progress in the resolution of air navigation deficiencies related to the AOP, ATM and AIM fields.
 - Certification of 33 Aerodromes and Publication of Status of Certification of Aerodromes in AIP, AD 1.5 by 17 States
 - AIS Quality Management System (Annex 15): 20 States
 - WGS-84 Requirements (Annex 15): 9 States
 - SAR capability (Annex 12): 32 States



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
